### **AREA D OVERVIEW:**

Area D is located south and southwest of the City of Salmon Arm. It is considered the agricultural heartland of the Shuswap, and includes the communities of Cedar Hill, Falkland, Ranchero, Deep Creek and Silver Creek, as well as Gardom Lake. Area D has close ties with both the North Okanagan Regional District and Thompson Nicola Regional District.

This area offers strong scenic values, but unlike most other areas in the Shuswap it has a countryside/agriculture rather than lakeside feel. The Salmon River is a central feature within Area D, providing a source for irrigation and opportunities for recreational activities.

Unlike other areas of the Shuswap that have a high proportion of seasonal residents, the population of Area D is much more consistent year-round.







# TOTAL POPULATION BY AGE GROUPS (% DISTRIBUTION):




# TOTAL POPULATION BY MARITAL STATUS (% DISTRIBUTION):






# TOTAL POPULATION BY LIVING SITUATION (% DISTRIBUTION):




